



HOTEL, TRAVEL, MEETING & REGISTRATION INFORMATION

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

The conference will be hosted at the New Radisson Hotel Miami. It is located at 1601 Biscayne Blvd., Miami, FL 33132. This stunning hotel with floor to ceiling windows overlooks Biscayne Bay, downtown Miami and Miami proper. Next door to the hotel is a major transportation hub including the Metromover (individualized motorized cars that circle downtown Miami on an elevated track) as well as local buses. The Metromover will take you to Bayside Marketplace, a shopping and entertainment complex with restaurants and food pavilions. Anchored next to the Marketplace are tour and casino boats which embark several times a day. Miami Beach, the famous Art Deco District and Lincoln Road are minutes from the hotel and easily accessible by bus or taxi. In addition to our hotel's amenities on site, there are two fast food restaurants directly across the street from the hotel as well as coffee shops, delis and full-service restaurants overlooking Biscayne Bay accessible via a covered walkway across the street from the hotel. The special room rate for the conference is: \$109 (Single-Quad). Junior suites (\$149) and one-bedroom suites (\$185) are also available for conference attendees. These rates are only guaranteed through March 13, 2005. After that date, the rate is available on a "space and rate available" basis. Be sure and identify yourself as an ASGPP conference attendee to obtain the special discount rate. We have also arranged for this rate to apply 3 days before and 3 days after the conference to encourage you to spend some time in Miami, Miami Beach, Coconut Grove, Coral Gables and charming neighborhoods such as South Beach and Little Havana before or after the conference.

We strongly urge you to "RESERVE YOUR ROOM IMMEDIATELY" as there will be another major event in the hotel on Saturday night and so the hotel may be sold out that night.

ROOM SHARING

If you wish to share a hotel room and do not already have a roommate, check the space provided on the conference registration form. Each participant in our room sharing service will receive the names and contact information of other people who have expressed an interest in sharing a room. It is your responsibility to contact others on the list and make all roommate arrangements and hotel reservations. (The ASGPP is not responsible for any arrangements that fall through). Because of the size of the hotel, we anticipate that rooms set aside for the ASGPP may all be taken prior to the March 13 cut-off date. It is recommended you reserve a room at the hotel immediately and then when you find a roommate you or your roommate can cancel your reservation observing hotel cancellation policies. The application deadline for this Room Sharing Service is March 1, 2005. Remember the hotel is only obligated to honor ASGPP rates through March 13, 2005.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Early registration is encouraged as workshop choices are not guaranteed even if your forms are received by March 14.
- Workshops are filled on a first come, first served basis. Space is limited, so please indicate your 1st, 2nd and 3rd choices. Not having your 2nd & 3rd Choices will delay your registration process.
- To receive the early registration discount, your forms must be post-marked by March 14.
- **Attendees registering by mail with a postmark after March 14, 2005 must pay the on-site rate.**
- Member rates are only for those who have paid their 2005 Membership Dues.
- Anyone paying member rates, who has not paid their dues to the ASGPP for 2005, will be invoiced for those dues.

REFUND POLICY

- If post-marked before March 14, 2005, attendees will receive a full refund less a \$50 processing fee.
- If post-marked between March 15 & March 31, 2005, attendees will receive a full refund less 30% or \$50 whichever is greater.
- If post-marked after March 31, 2005, no refunds will be given.
- All refunds will be issued during the week of May 2, 2005.

CREDIT CARD USAGE & CHARGES

The ASGPP prefers payment by check or money order in US funds but understands that it can be more convenient for individuals to use their credit card. If you are unable to pay with a check drawn on a US bank and prefer to use your credit card there is a 3% processing and handling charge added to the total amount due.

GETTING TO MIAMI

Two major airports serve Miami. Miami International and Fort Lauderdale. Fort Lauderdale is served by several US discount airlines and the major airlines generally are forced to match those lower prices. When you check rates, be sure and check the rates to Fort Lauderdale. Amtrak serves Miami from all over the United States with daily service from the Northeast. Those who live in South Florida know that there there is train service via Tri-Rail from West Palm Beach to Miami and via Metrorail going west to Hialeah and south to Kendall.

GETTING TO THE RADISSON FROM AIRPORTS

A taxi from Miami International Airport is approximately \$20 and a group can share that rate. Super Shuttle service is also available from the Miami airport. Fort Lauderdale has shuttle service directly to the hotel. Simply go outside of the baggage area and ask for a shuttle to Miami. The fee is approximately \$15.
