Hotel direction: 10 miles SE

Driving Directions: Exit Airport. Take I-95 North to I-676 West (Central Philadelphia). Exit at Broad Street (Route 611), stay in left lane. Take your first left onto Vine Street. Proceed on Vine Street to 12th Street. Turn right on 12th Street to Market Street, right onto Market Street to City Hall. Hotel will be on your right immediately after first traffic light.

SHUTTLE SERVICES FROM AIRPORT TO HOTEL

The Courtyard Marriott does not provide shuttle service.

- Alternate transportation: Lady Liberty Transportation Co.(shuttle service); fee: 10 USD (one way) , on request **(215) 724-8888**
- You may also use Tropiano shuttle service **(215) 616-5370**. They have a white telephone down by baggage. You pick it up and tell them which hotel and they will pick you up at the curb. \$11.00 one way.

Taxi Services

Taxi services can be picked up at Zone 5 on the Commercial Transportation Roadway.

All Taxi rates are based per trip not per person. Most taxis can accommodate up to 3 passengers. In some cases certain vehicle types can accommodate 4 passengers.

\$28.50 Flat Rate from the Airport to the Central Philadelphia Area. An additional \$1.00 per passenger (\$3.00 maximum) after the first passenger will be charged on flat rate trips between the Airport and Center City for passengers over age 12. In addition you will be charged an additional \$1.50 Airport fee.

Should you need to pay by credit card please advise the dispatcher upon your arrival to the Taxi area as all companies do not accept credit cards or vouchers as a form of payment.

SETPA Train System

If you are subway friendly you may take the SEPTA rail . The trains stop right outside the airport and come into downtown Philly – Take Line R1 to Suburban Station - Walk out of the station and head towards Capitol Building and Hotel is across the street. Cost is approximately \$8.50 one way

Directions to the Philadelphia Downtown Courtyard

From the North: Until I-95 South – Trenton, Princeton

From the South: Using I-95 North- Philadelphia Airport, Baltimore, Washington DC

Take I-95 to exit 22 which is Central Philadelphia via Callowhill Street. Go straight on Callowhill until you reach 12th Street. Make a left onto 12th Street and go eight blocks until you reach Market Street. Make a right onto Market, and continue for two blocks. There, you will be forced to make a right (City Hall will be right in front of you). Stay in the right lane and the hotel is the second building on the right.

From the Northeast: Using the PA Turnpike, Northeast Extension, and Route 9

Follow the Northeast Extension of the PA Turnpike until it ends. Connect to I-476 South to exit 6B which is for I-76 East headed towards Philadelphia. Proceed on I-76 East to exit 344 for I-676 East/Central Philadelphia. Take I-676 for one mile to the Broad Street Exit. At the end of the ramp, stay to your left for Vine Street. Go three lights until you reach 12th Street. Make a right onto 12th Street and continue four blocks to Market Street. Make a right onto Market, and continue for two blocks. There, you will be forced to make a right (City Hall will be right in front of you). Stay in the right lane and the hotel is the second building on the right.

From the East: Using the New Jersey Turnpike—Northern Jersey, New York

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to exit 4 for Camden/Philadelphia. Stay to the right to the toll booths. Take Route 73 North to Route 38 West. Proceed on Route 38 West to Route 30 West. Continue on 30 West to the Benjamin Franklin Bridge, and continue across the bridge staying in the center lane and then connect to I-676 West towards Central Philadelphia. Proceed on I-676 West for one mile to the Broad Street exit. At the end of the ramp stay on the left for Vine Street. Go three lights until you reach 12th Street. Make a right onto 12th Street and continue four blocks to Market Street. Make a right onto Market, and continue for two blocks. There, you will be forced to make a right (City Hall will be right in front of you). Stay in the right lane and the hotel is the second building on the right.

From the West: Using the PA Turnpike—Penn State and Pittsburgh

Take the PA Turnpike East to exit 24 for Valley Forge/I-76 East. Proceed onto I-76 East for 17 miles to exit 34 for Central Philadelphia via Broad Street. At the end of the ramp, stay to your left for Vine Street. . Go three lights until you reach 12th Street. Make a right onto 12th Street and continue four blocks to Market Street. Make a right onto Market, and continue for two blocks. There, you will be forced to make a right (City Hall will be right in front of you). Stay in the right lane and the hotel is the second building on the right.

From Southern New Jersey: Using the Walt Whitman Bridge, Shore Points

Take the Atlantic City Expressway West to the end, merging with Route 42 North to I-676 North to the Ben Franklin Bridge. Go across the bridge, staying in the middle lane. Take the Vine Street exit and continue on Vine until 12th Street. Turn left onto 12th Street and continue to Market Street. Make a

right onto Market, and continue for two blocks. There, you will be forced to make a right (City Hall will be right in front of you). Stay in the right lane and the hotel is the second building on the right.
