Archives Committee

Charge: study and develop process for soliciting, securing, storing literature or other media appropriate for archiving.

Awards Committee

Charge: to establish criteria and identify those people in the Society who are eligible for receiving awards as established by the Society. This committee will investigate applications for membership as a Fellow and make recommendations to the Executive Council for their election.

Charge: provide process whereby those attending workshops sponsored by the Society can receive CEU's. Work in conjunction with Program Committee of Annual conference and other Regional Chapter meetings, to provide workshops which facilitate continuing professional development of members.

Evaluation Committee

Charge: develop procedures for and conduct an evaluation of annual meeting events, workshops, annual business meeting, provide a summary of the annual meeting to the Conference Committee and Executive Council, seek ways to elicit feedback from members concerning the functioning of the Society and the ways the organization functions, conduct other evaluations as requested by Executive Council, distribute feedback evaluations results to all presenters.

Finance Committee

Charge: examine the fiscal operations of the organization, make recommendations to Executive Council based on that examination, determine feasibility of a permanent central office, explore other sources of revenue, assist in the creation of a new role for management of the central office.

International Committee

Charge: Members of the Council and Society share information about the ASGPP to other organizations outside the United States and collect information about conferences and trainings from around the world to share with the members of the Society.

Library Committee

Charge: Members of the Council and Society will oversee the online Library of books and articles of interest to the Society. Members may submit suggestions at anytime and the committee will review for posting.

Membership Committee

Charge: oversee the work of National office in reviewing applications for membership and ascertain eligibility for membership category applied for and receipt of dues, conduct membership campaigns, prepare membership info, send new members an information packet, answer all correspondence related to membership, maintain an up to date file of all current members and category of membership, refer requests for membership as a Fellow to the Awards Committee.

Nominations Committee

Charge: elected chair and committee shall annually submit a Call for Nominations to membership, prepare a slate of nominations for Ex. Council and Officers, in accordance with the by-laws, submit the slate to the membership, supervise the election, and report the results.

Professional Standards Committee

Charge: elected chair and committee deal with any improprieties from or regarding a member of the Society. This committee makes recommendations for action to the Executive Council.

Publicity Committee

Charge: oversee all publicity of the Society to insure they meet guidelines for content and design. Oversee policies for advertising with the ASGPP, review all content and placement of Ads placed on behalf of the Society in publications outside of the Society.
