## REMEMBERING Rochelle Haskell

Rochelle J. "Chelly" Haskell, MA (1922- 2004), co-founded the California Institute of Socioanalysis, with her husband, Martin Haskell, located in Long Beach, CA. This grand lady was a stalwart member of ASGPP from the early 1950s! After Martin's death, her companion was Carl Pearl, with whom she published *A World in Microcosm*, a book which deals with group interaction and psychodrama techniques as well as several other monographs on themes related to psychodrama, substance abuse, etc. Their audiotape *Psychodrama and Our World* explores the inherent value of psychodrama as an adjunct to ongoing group psychotherapy. In the earlier years, she attended the ASGPP conferences. She obtained a Masters degree in speech pathology, and worked in various hospitals and clinics. Madelyn Hathaway and some other friends were major supports in her more recent years. She will be missed.
