Categories of Membership

Regular Members \$130

Any person who supports the aims and standards of the Society is eligible to become a regular member. Members in good standing shall be eligible to vote at meetings and other proceedings of the society, chair and serve on committees and seek nomination for elected positions.

Student/Retiree Member \$65

A student member is anyone enrolled in an accredited college/university program for 12 hours of undergraduate course credits or 9 hours of graduate course credits. Student applicants must enclose a current copy of their student ID and a copy of their current course schedule.

Retirees are those who are no longer practicing or training, or gainfully employed.
