FROM THE ASGPP COMMITTEES:

Awards Committee

Based on the recently-approved change to the Bylaws, the Honors Committee establishes the criteria and identifies those people in the Society who have made significant educational or research contributions in psychodrama, sociometry and group psychotherapy, and who may be eligible for awards as established by the Society. Because the 2020 conference was cancelled, honors that were to be given at that conference will now be awarded at the 2021 conference. One new award, the "Young Professionals Award" will be submitted to the membership.

Continuing Education Committee (CEU)

The Continuing Education Committee reviewed the company and mechanism through which continuing education credits are offered for the annual conference and other ASGPP-sponsored trainings. The Committee explored many different options and contacted other similar professional organizations. Professional Liaison Committee

The most recent initiative of the Professional Liaison Committee has been focused on further integrating Moreno's methods into academia - specifically university programs. The committee created and published a "Best Practices" for teaching psychodrama in university settings in collaboration with over a dozen psychodrama trainers who have experience teaching psychodrama at universities. Furthermore, we collected a database of over a dozen psychodrama syllabi from various university programs and obtained permissions to make them publicly available on our website.

Professional Standards Committee

The purpose of this Committee is to maintain the ethical and professional standards of the ASGPP by investigating complaints. This fall, the Committee has reviewed the current policy and is recommending updates to the Executive Council to guide future considerations of Professional Standard Committee reports.

Research Committee

This Committee is meeting bi-monthly and exploring psychodrama application for Evidence Based Practice; developing a mentorship program for research; and promoting psychodrama research in the ASGPP. The Committee is collaborating with international psychodrama researchers and group therapy researchers; developing a survey for ASGPP membership on research; reevaluating the multisite research project created by previous co-chairs; and creating an annotated list of research instruments for psychodrama. The Committee organized the first international psychodrama research panel for the 2020 ASGPP conference which was cancelled due to COVID.

Sociatry and Social Justice Committee

The Sociatry and Social Justice Committee is to create space to discuss, enact, use

sociatry, sociometry and sociodrama to explore issues of social justice. These explorations will be brainstormed into workshops and other formats to assist psychodramatists to facilitate in their own communities and, to use the social microscope in our own ASGPP community. Ultimately, the members of ASGPP, the organization itself can become a center for change in the world.

Our actions are to work with Executive Committee and Paula De Franco and Ed Schrieber to gain clarity and structure for the careful building of a foundation that will contain the inevitably messy conversations in a safe manner. We need to look at how we can offer encounter sessions. We need to figure out how to create a working committee with the intestinal fortitude to face strong emotional knee jerks and other responses without taking them personally. Our current actions are to implement sociatry workshops and explore future actions.

Website Committee

The Website Committee navigated several challenges to bring the new ASGPP website to fruition. It continues to go through refinements and upgrades. In addition, the Committee created a new YouTube Page and migrated videos from the old page to the new page.

We need to connect with publicity committee people to get us and our events “out there” beyond the bubble of our membership. We would like ideas for monetizing the website to bring in money for the ASGPP and that also get us greater positive visibility. We are now thinking about the future and would like ideas from visionaries who are willing to join the committee and bring the website into the future.
