

Affordable Transportation Options from NYC Airports to The Bronx (And best options for disabled / handicapped Conference attendees)

According to the Fordham University website,

TAXI CABS - Direct to the Bronx

- A typical taxi ride from LGA (Laguardia Airport) to the Bronx is: **\$40 + tolls + tip.**
- A typical taxi ride from JFK to the Bronx is between **\$52 - \$57 + tolls + tip.**
- A typical taxi ride from Newark to the Bronx is **around \$70 + tolls + tip**

CAR SERVICES - Direct to the Bronx

There are also a few car service companies listed on their website.

One of these car services is available 24/7. When you land at the airport, pick up your luggage and then call the company when you are ready to be picked up. They will then send a driver directly to you at the airport.

ANOTHER OPTION

(if coming from Manhattan OR transferring from airport to Manhattan to The Bronx)

Fordham's website states that the typical total price from Laguardia to their Midtown / Manhattan campus is about **\$35 by taxi.**

Then, from the Midtown campus, there is a shuttle that is operated by Fordham, called a [Ram Van](#), that could take you from the Manhattan campus directly to the Bronx campus for **\$3.50** one way.

This is a relatively small shuttle that is mostly used for students, so should be covid-safe.

More expensive: for Wheelchair Accessible / Handicap Transportation

NYC Wheelchair Accessible Transportation service -

a private handicap accessible van that would cost about **\$160** and take you directly from LGA to the Bronx Rose Hill campus. This cost will vary depending on what airport you are arriving to, but will roughly be about **\$160 - \$200.**
